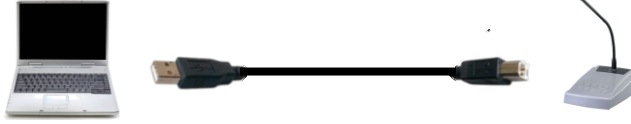




# Message Repeater Software Guideline

## Unit / Software Setup

**Step 1:** Confirm that the **USB** cable is hooked up between the **PC** and the **PM-20EV** base.



**Step 2:** Double click on the **Message Repeater Software** shortcut on your desktop.



## Setup Of Message File

**Step 1:** In the top right hand side of the software there are multiple model number options – make sure the **PM-20EV** is selected.

**Step 2:** Type the message name in the "Project Name" text box in the upper right half of the software window.

**Step 3:** Locate the .wav file to be inserted by using the "**SELECT FOLDER**" Button in the bottom middle of the screen.

**Step 4:** A Dialogue box will pop up allowing you to search for the folder where the message .wav file is saved. Select the desired folder and click "**OK**".

**Step 5:** The folder will appear in the box in the lower left of the software. Click the "**+**" to expand the contents and locate the desired audio file.

**Step 6:** Confirm that the text of the file matches with 8 characters on the left side of the period and finishes with .wav

### **Step 7:**

- Click, hold, and drag the file into the first box under the "**FILE NAME**" heading on the right half of the software.
- A window will pop up asking to name the new parameter file – type in whatever name you like and click "**SAVE**".
- The software will ask you if you want to create a project file – click "**YES**".
- A Dialogue box will pop up letting you know a file has been created – click "**OK**".
- A dialogue box will pop up asking if you want to save the wave file you just inserted – click "**YES**".
- A pop-up "**FORMAT**" window with a progress meter will then appear and will ask you to repeat the "**SAVE : YES: OK: SAVE**" routine again.

### <<<<<< **NOTE** >>>>>>

If you wish the audio file to repeat automatically at regular intervals up to 1 hour, this is selectable in the drop down menu to the right of the file name.

**Step 8:** At this point, the arrows in the center of the software (pointing to the left) will go from **GREY** [**<**] to **BLACK** [**<**] – click on them to upload the file to the **PM-20EV** base.

The file is now ready for playback from the **PM-20EV**.
